

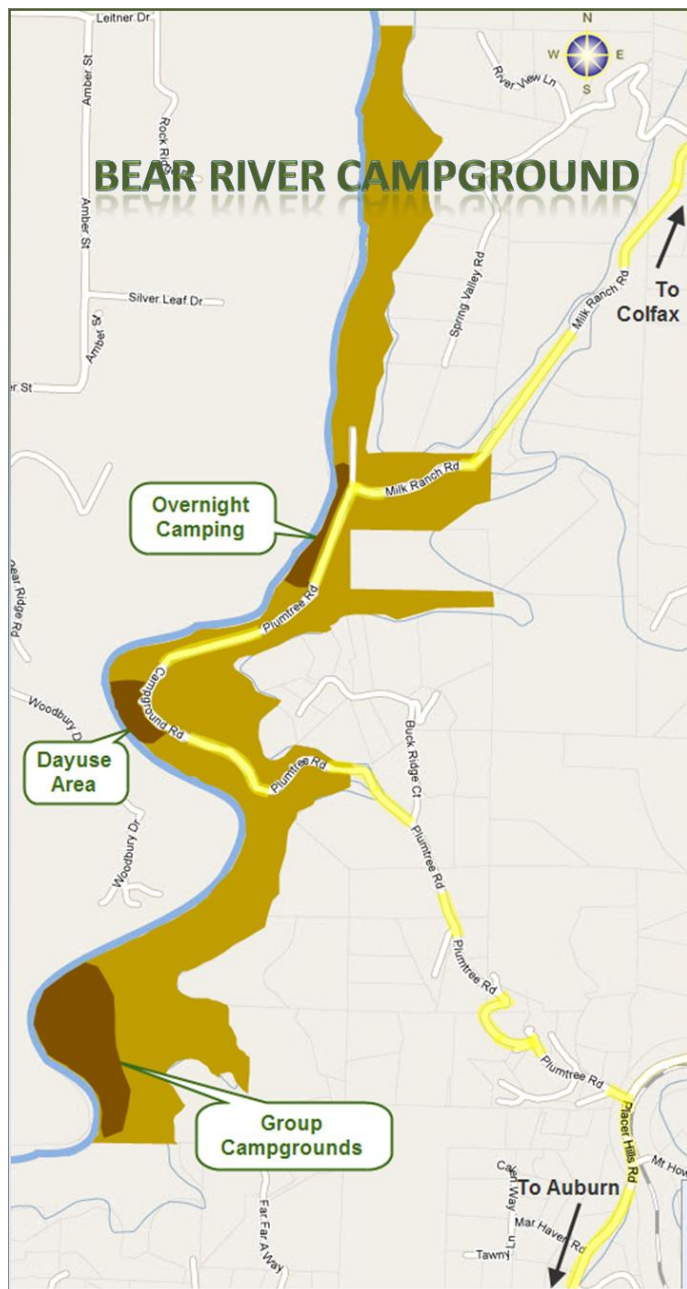
Bear River Solstice Celebration
